2. Entries must be in the English Language.
3. An entry fee of €20 must be included with each individual entry.
4. See note on entry form for payment methods.
5. Entries may have been previously published or broadcast but must not have won any award, in any competition, prior to the closing date for entries, 30th March 2012.
6. Entries should not contain any indication of the writers identity on the competition entry; please use the official form available on our website or requested by post from our competition address below.
7. Entries must be typed, using double spacing and submitted in duplicate.
8. An unlimited number of entries can be submitted for this competition provided the requisite fee and form accompanies each entry.
9. Entries will not be returned.
10. Awards will only be made where a satisfactory standard is achieved.
11. No correspondence will be entered into regarding entries.
12. The adjudicator's decision will be final.
13. Winner, second and runners-up only, will be notified.
14. Those on the shortlist will be notified by post / e-mail on or before 31st May, 2012.

All prizes will be presented at a ceremony in Mitchelstown, on Saturday, 21st July 2012.

The names of the Winner, 2nd prize and runners-up will be posted to the competition website when they become available.
